- a. 10 calls for service on March 16,
- b. 15-20 phone calls each day, Shar and Teresa did a great job answering each call.
- c. Placerville union school district has been using our parking lot for a drive through lunch program for kids in the mosquito area. It runs from 1130 to 1230 each day, it started on March 18 and will go through March 27.
- d. PVC check arrived \$1,717.75.
- e. Kincade fire check arrived \$65,645.07
- f. Lauren Ono was of great assistance during the snow storm and its aftermath.
- g. Mailed CSFA grant applications for turnout gear, they were received now submitting reimbursement requests.
- h. We were able to save some of the turnouts for our explorers.
- i. Had to cancel PPE measurements with Cascade fire. Mike and Suzi have doing Wildland measurements and by next week we should be able to do Structure PPE measurements.
- j. We have 2 E series monitor defibrillators that we carry on our equipment, the company that sells them (Zoll) will not service them after January 1st 2021. So we are applying for a grant with the Rescue fire department for the new X series monitor Defibrillator. This is a 10 % grant. The monitor is \$35,000 so we would pay \$3,500. We will be adding on an auto pulse which is a very simple to Use CPR machine, it will cost us \$2,000, and they will take the E series for trade ins.
- k. Captain Mike Walters and Engineer Jeff Schwegler drove Engine 275 to a birthday drive by at 6440 Claim to celebrate Charlies birthday. This was done on March 31 st.
