1. New 22 KW generator installed,new 500-gallon tank. Trent and I did the acceptance test and it passed.
2. Water tanks. Director Pico, Assistant Chief Nugent and Division Chief Marouk are going to work on this assignment as a part of community risk reduction they will have a plan to present to the board when it is complete.
3. Community yard sale has generated \$1540.00So far.
4. MQT bridge shut down starting July 13. Does anyone have any more information?
5. Just completed S130, S190 for our new Volunteers this class has not been taught here for many years, we have a first-rate instructor with B/C Mike Walters. We spent a day at Finnon lake completing progressive hose lays, shelter deployment's, hand line construction. Instructors were B/C Walters, B/C Schwegler, Engineer Morris, Engineer Schwegler. What is really encouraging was that we also trained our explorer/ Cadet students up to the wildland standard. We Have a total of 4 local residents who did a great job: Sharalee Reis, Greyson Dillender, Trevor Dillender, Devin Hern. It's exciting to see family members with a long family history at Mosquito fire following in their parents and grandparents' footsteps. It is about community it's about family.

6. Another Class taught for the first time was Driver Operator 1A, and we had personnel from PGE, San Luis Obispo fire, and our own Paid and Volunteer staff. So, lots happening more to come as we get up and running.
7. The current Paid and Volunteer staff are currently taking RT-130 which is a refresher class that is required every year, this is being done on line through target solutions and this is getting done so that we can all get our Red cards for strike teams.

12. Shar submitted all the PVC training hours for the Spring semester, this includes all training activities including Ryans Purves Paramedic class and our normal monthly training.
