Fire Fighter

Salary \$30,551 - \$37,128

The Position: The Fire Fighter position is a salaried position operating under the general direction of the Chief. Normal duty schedule shall consist of eight (8) hours per day, five (5) days per week. The Chief shall establish the duty schedule. Interested applicants should be aware that the successful candidate may be working weekend shifts.

Duties: The primary responsibility of the position is to suppress structure fires, wild land fires, provide medical aid, and perform various other emergency services as needed by the community. Additionally, under the general direction of the Chief, the successful candidate will be expected to inspect, maintain, and repair, as necessary, the fire station, station grounds and other related MFPD assets.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Possess a CA Firefighter 1 Certification or have successfully completed a Basic Firefighter Academy recognized by the CA State Fire Marshall's Office.
- Be physically capable of functioning to the arduous standards as established for a MFPD volunteer fire fighter.
- Possess (or obtain within 60 days of hire) and maintain a current El Dorado County EMS certification at Emergency Medical Technician 1 level.
- Possess (or obtain within 60 days of hire) valid California Class C Driver's License with Fire Fighter Endorsement.

Desirable Qualification:

- Be a current resident in the district at time of hire or at the completion of the probationary period.
- Two years full time experience as Firefighter.
- California Physical Ability Test (CPAT) certificate, valid at time of interview.
- Completion of Driver/Operator 1A &1B.

Compensation:

The starting salary is established by the selection committee within the posted range depending of experience and qualification. A step raise is awarded after successfully completing a 1 year probationary period and annually thereafter, based on performance, until the top step is reached. Additionally, the District contributes 9% of the annual salary into an approved Retirement Plan and up to \$750 per month into a health insurance program selected by the employee. After completing the probation period, additional benefits include annual paid vacation leave, 40 work hours sick leave, and paid time off for each of the following "Holidays"; Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, Thanksgiving, and Friday immediately following, Easter, President's Day, and Memorial Day.

Selection Procedure:

Employment applications and resumes will be reviewed.

Successful candidates may participate in;

- Written Exam
- Assessment Center
- Skills Assessment
- Physical Agility Test (physical agility is pass/fail)

Most qualified candidates may be invited to participate in an oral interview with the Fire Chief.

The tentative testing date is January 16th, 2016.
