Invites applicants for the position:

Limited Term Fire Captain

(Temporary Position)

January 2016 – June 30, 2016

Wage: (\$21.00--\$25.00 per hour depending on qualifications)

The Position: The Limited Term Fire Captain position is a temporary part time position operating under the general direction of the Chief. This position is created primarily to supplement regular employee staffing and 2 positions are available. This position may be extended should funding become available.

Normal duty time shall consist of eight (8) hours per day, two (2) to four (4) days per week. The Chief shall establish the duty schedule. Interested applicants should be aware that the successful candidate may be working weekend shifts.

Duties: Under direction of the Fire Chief, the Fire Captain directs the activities of the engine company personnel assigned to his/her shift. The Fire Captain is responsible for the supervision and direction of paid and volunteer personnel on all emergency incidents, their performance of routine duties, apparatus maintenance, equipment and facility maintenance, and other activities as may be assigned to the shift by the Fire Chief. The Fire Captain is also responsible for the completion of administrative and fire prevention assignments, and the development and presentation of training activities.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Have successfully completed a Basic Firefighter Academy
- Be physically capable of functioning to the arduous standards as established for a MFPD volunteer fire fighter.
- Valid California Class C Driver's License with Fire Fighter Endorsement.
- IS700 and IS800 (NIMS)
- EMT-I (EMT-I certification must meet Title 22, CCR).

Desirable Qualifications:

- Two years full time experience as Fire Engineer/Fire Lieutenant/Fire Captain
- California Physical Ability Test (CPAT) certificate, valid at time of interview.
- Completion of Driver/Operator 1A & 1B.
- Possess an AA, AS or higher degree from an approved college or university.
- ICS 300
- California State Fire Training Fire Instructor Certification
- California State Fire Training Fire Officer Certification

Compensation:

The compensation shall be \$21.00 to \$25.00 per work hour, depending on qualifications. Sick leave accrued at 1 hour per 30 hours worked after 30 days. There are no additional paid benefits associated with this position.

As is inherent in any emergency service position, additional work time may be necessary during extended emergency incidents and to satisfy the requirements of assuring the readiness of fire apparatus and equipment for immediate response.

When approved by the Chief, the employee will be compensated for this additional time worked by granting time off during a normal duty day at the rate of one (1) hour off for each hour worked in excess of the normal duty week.

This section does not apply to emergency responses after duty hours if the employee is acting in the capacity of a MFPD Volunteer Firefighter.

Application Process:

Deadline for the Application Process:

Monday, January 11th, 2016 by 1600 hours. No postmarks, emails or faxes will be accepted after this time.

Selection Procedure:

Employment applications and resumes will be reviewed.

Successful candidates may participate in;

- Written Exam
- Assessment Center
- Skills Assessment
- Physical Agility Test (physical agility is pass/fail)

Most qualified candidates may be invited to participate in an oral interview with the Fire Chief.

The tentative testing date will be January, 17th, 2016.
